FOR REPLACING SELECTED FIREYE 25SU5 MODELS WITH 70D40/70D41 FIREYE CONTROLS

DESCRIPTION

FIREYE, Modernization Adapter #60-2060-15 assists the replacement of Fireye 25SU5 models listed below using modular Fireye 70D40-41, with 72DUVS4 self-checking amplifier and using existing 45UV5-1005 or 1105 self-checking UV detector.

1. Loosen the two chassis retaining screws and remove the chassis from its enclosure. Note the chassis type and model number.



2. Fireye 25SU5 controls may be wired and operated in a variety of methods. The circuit diagram on page 3 illustrates the interconnection between the 25SU5 and 70D40-41 control. It shows the recommended method of connecting the supply, limit switch, and momentary start switch, as well as the two SPDT relay circuits whose function is the same for both 25SU5 and 70D40-41 controls. All wiring must have 600 volt insulation.

- **3.** Note the typical circuit diagram for complete information.
- **4.** Install the Modernization Adapter and tighten the two retaining screws.




5. Assemble the control and module and install the unit into the Modernization Adapter. Tighten the chassis retainer.




- **6.** Referring to Fireye bulletin D-4041 turn the power on. Initiate a normal burner startup and operational test as described for the D40 control unit.
- **7.** For assistance with non-standard installations contact your Fireye distributor (see publication F-100 or look in the Yellow pages under *Controls*.)








WIRING DIAGRAMS
