

### **Y75 Series Sensing Probes**

The Y75 Series Sensing Probes are used with Direct Spark Ignition (DSI), Hot Surface Ignition (HSI), and Intermittent Pilot Ignition (IPI) systems. Various lengths and mounting styles are available. Consult BASO Gas Products regarding sensing probes details required for your specific application.

# **A**pplication

A Y75 sensing probe of single construction can be used to sense main burner flame. In DSI, HSI and IPI applications, the sensor is used as a remote sensor or in conjunction with a pilot burner assembly. If flame is sensed, the ignition control allows the main gas valve to remain open until the appliance thermostat is satisfied.

# General Construction

The Y75 is a Kanthal D or Hoskins 815 rod in a Steatite ceramic insulator mounted to a plated cold rolled steel bracket. Standard rod diameter is 0.114 in. (2.9 mm). Sensors are also available with a 0.084 in. (2.13 mm) diameter rod. Standard sensor leads are available in lengths from 6 to 48 in. (152 to 1,220 mm), in 6 in. (152 mm) increments with a maximum temperature rating of  $302^{\circ}F$  ( $150^{\circ}C$ ). High temperature sensor leads with a maximum temperature rating of  $482^{\circ}F$  ( $250^{\circ}C$ ) are also available. An insulated terminal on the sensor lead is optional.

#### Bend Specifications




Figure 2: Y75 Bend Specifications

The minimum distance between bends is 0.25 in. (6.35 mm). The minimum distance from the ceramic insulator to the first bend is 0.25 in. (6.35 mm). The maximum bend angle is 90 degrees, and the minimum bend radius is 0.063 in. (1.60 mm). The maximum number of bends per rod is two. See Figure 2.




Figure 3: Y75A Dimensions, in. (mm)






Figure 4: Y75B Dimensions, in. (mm)













Figure 6: Y75MK Dimensions, in. (mm)
